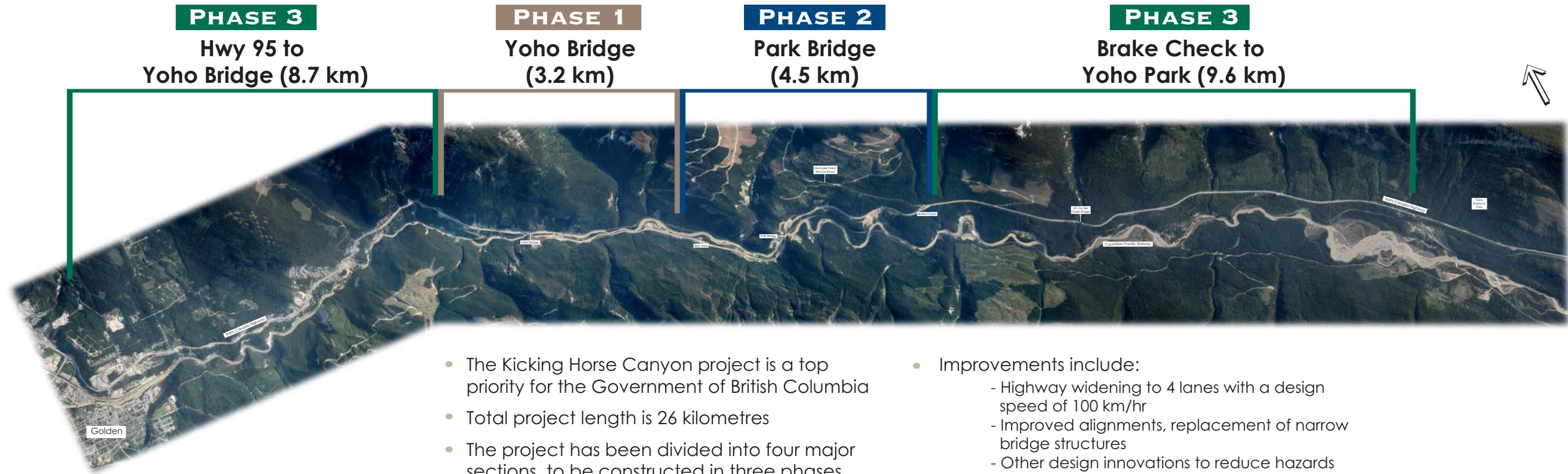


PROJECT OVERVIEW



- The Kicking Horse Canyon project is a top priority for the Government of British Columbia
- Total project length is 26 kilometres
- The project has been divided into four major sections, to be constructed in three phases
- Total cost is estimated at \$730 million, shared with the Government of Canada

- Improvements include:
 - Highway widening to 4 lanes with a design speed of 100 km/hr
 - Improved alignments, replacement of narrow bridge structures
 - Other design innovations to reduce hazards
- The route carries over 9,000 vehicles per day during the summer.
